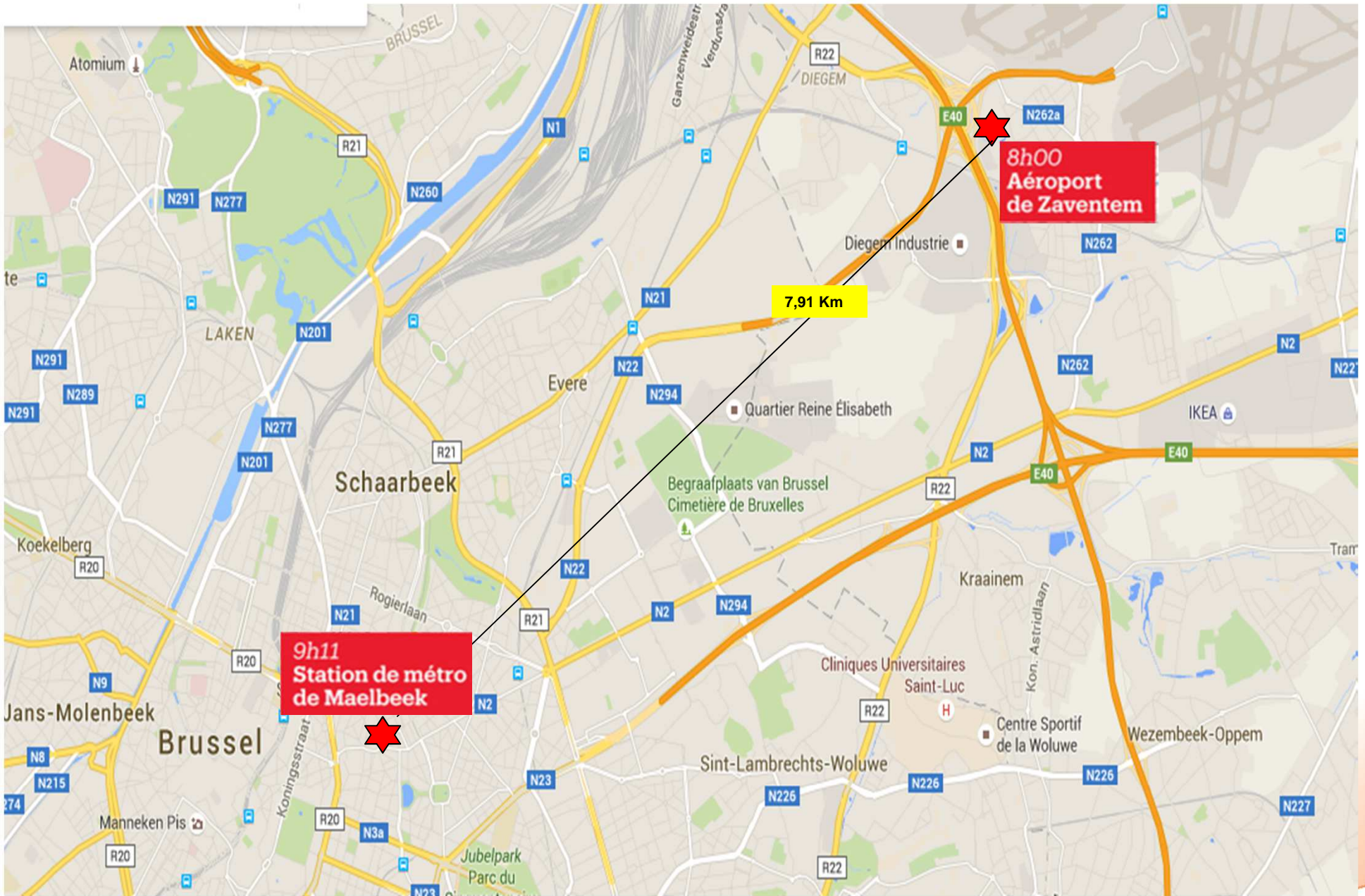

Terrorist attacks on Airport Zaventem – Subway Maelbeek

Never before in time of crisis

- Two attacks at almost the same time
(airport 7:58 and subway 9:10)
and in a short range (8 km= 4,97 miles)
- Same radio base stations in use for two sites
- Command centers Brussels:
Federal crisis center , police crisis cel, army crisis cel,
gouvernement, european commission ...
- One MTU
- Two Region communication centers (VBR and BRU)
- Brussels local police communication centers (BRU HGW, MONTY, ...)
- judicial operations (searches, arrests,)
- External clients Astrid (services subway, VUB security, ...)



Suicide bombing airport Brussels



At 7:58, a bomb exploded near the office of Brussels Airlines in the departure hall of the Airport. A second bomb exploded nine seconds later on the right side of the hall. At the airport fourteen people (including the two perpetrators) were killed. Nearly a hundred people were injured. The departure lounge was evacuated after the explosions. At the airport was still found a third unexploded bomb.

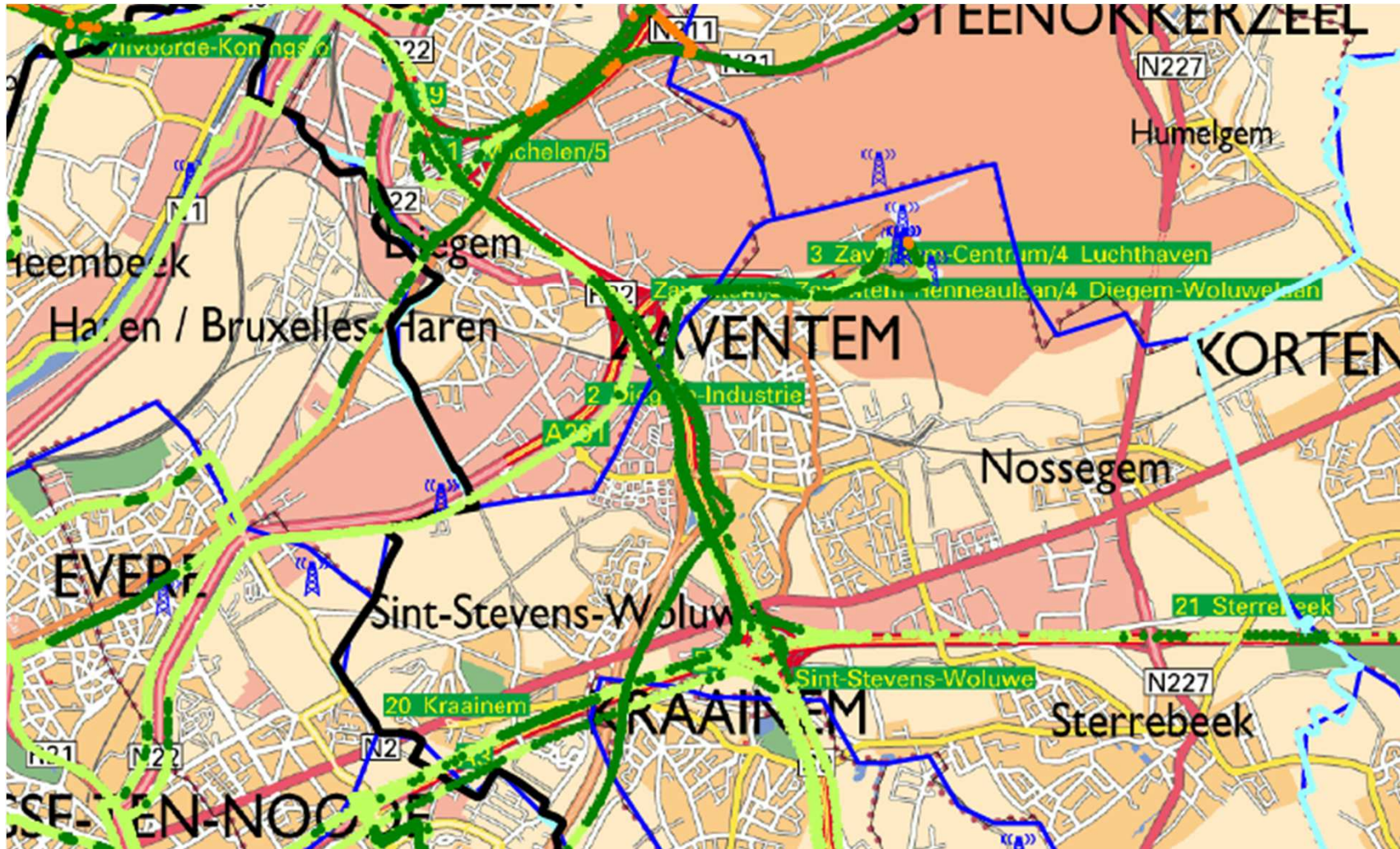
The Belgian federal prosecutor made later in the morning an announcement that it was a suicide bombing. One of the perpetrators was the Belgian Ibrahim El Bakraoui, brother of the perpetrator of the attack at Maalbeek; The other bomber was Najim Laachraoui.

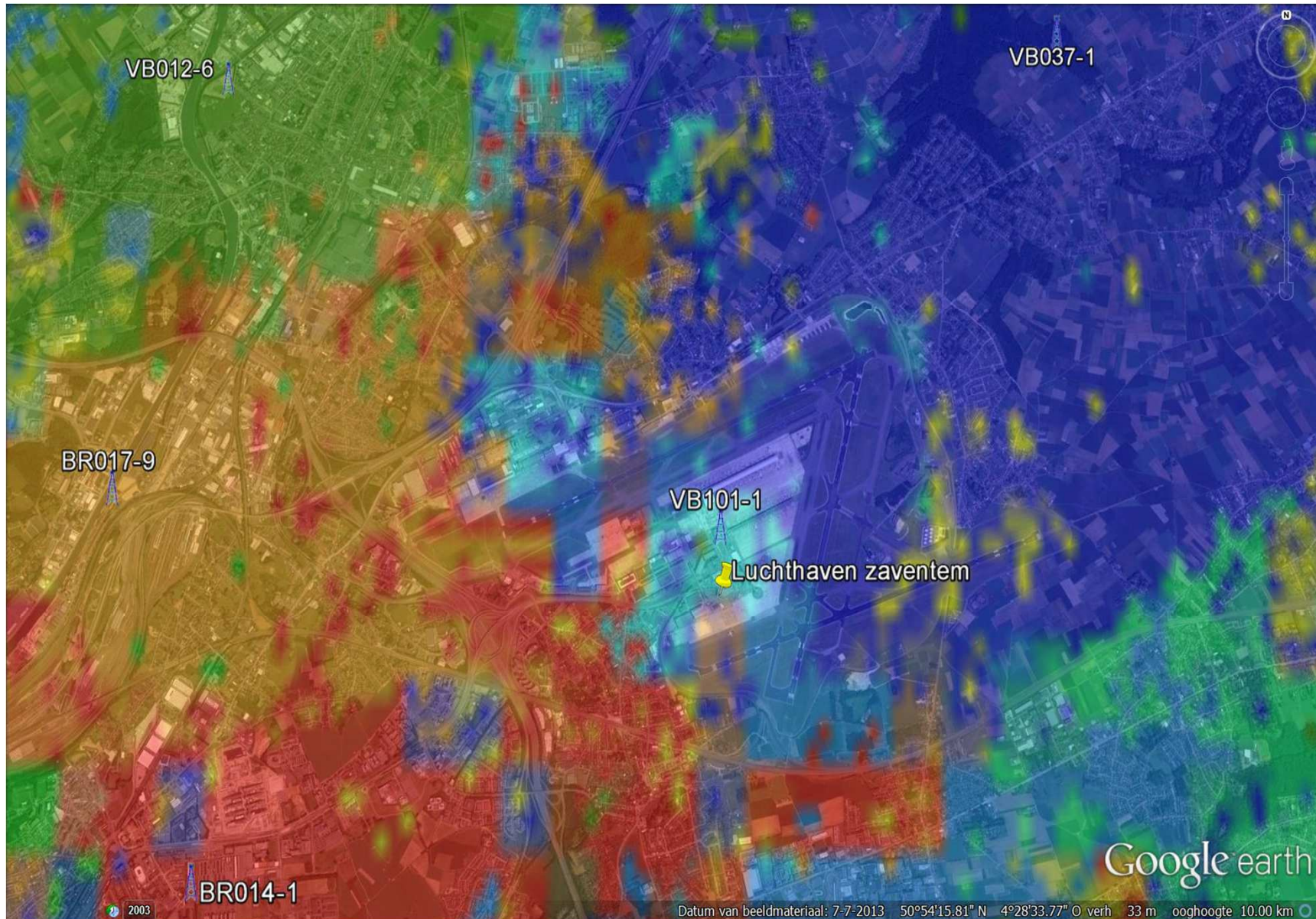

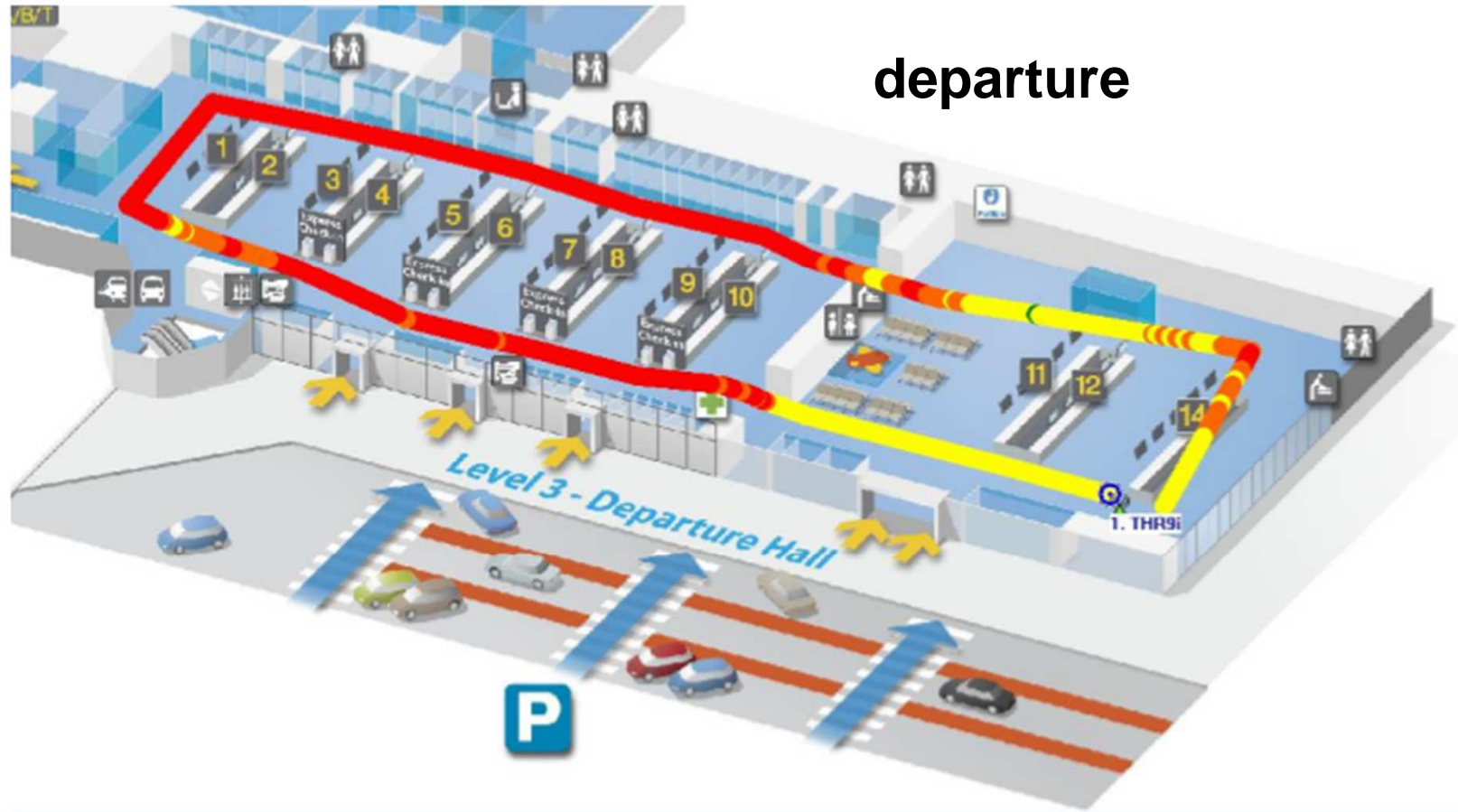
Radio coverage outdoor



Area coverage base stations



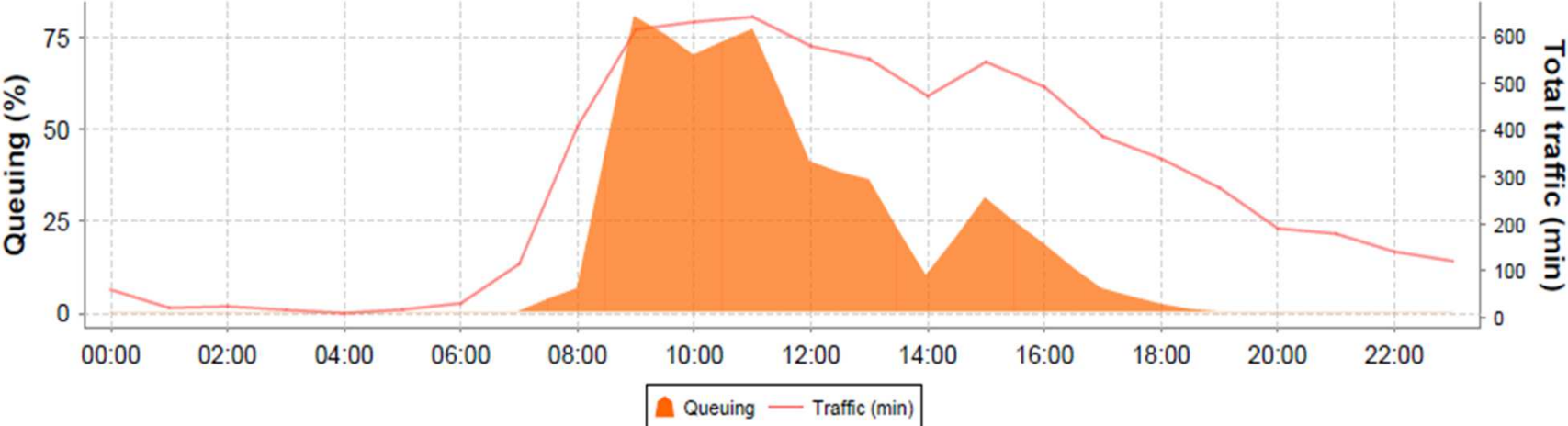
Couverage indoor

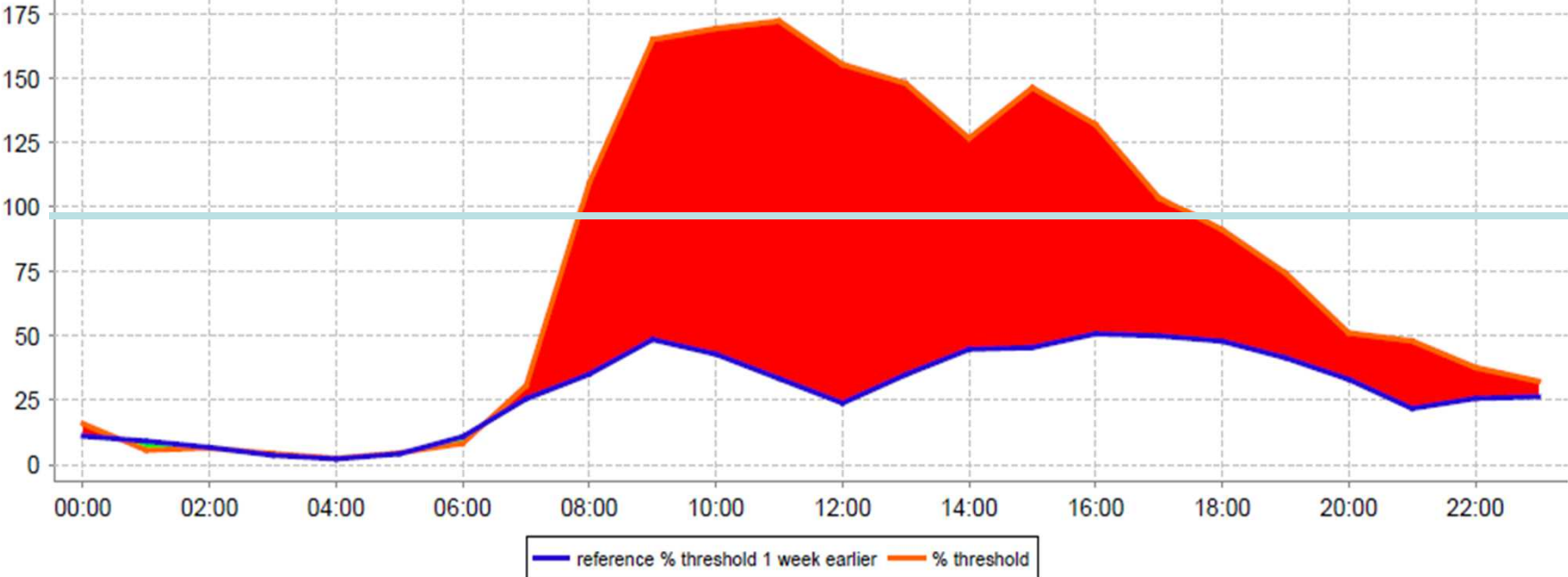

Bombing in the Brussels subway Maelbeek



Around 9:11 pm, just over an hour after the attacks at Brussels Airport, exploded under the European city a bomb in the middle of the three sets of a subway train STIB. This subway train had left a few seconds earlier from “Maelbeek” Metro Station, in the direction of the metro station “Arts-Loi”.

It turned out to be a suicide attack perpetrated by the Belgian Khalid El Bakraoui, the brother of the person who committed a suicide attack on the airport. Twenty-one people (including the author) were killed and more than a hundred people were injured, of whom seventeen seriously.

From the stop at Subway “Maelbeek” the smoke came partly out of the subway station “Arts-Loi”, so the rescue teams assumed that there had been an attack in this other stop.

Of the 578 groups used are 20 multidisciplinary, on the left the overview of the multidisciplinary groups with the number of calls. A total of 135 interviews in multidisciplinary groups happened, this is only 0.4% of the total number of group discussions on the masts in Brussels and surroundings.

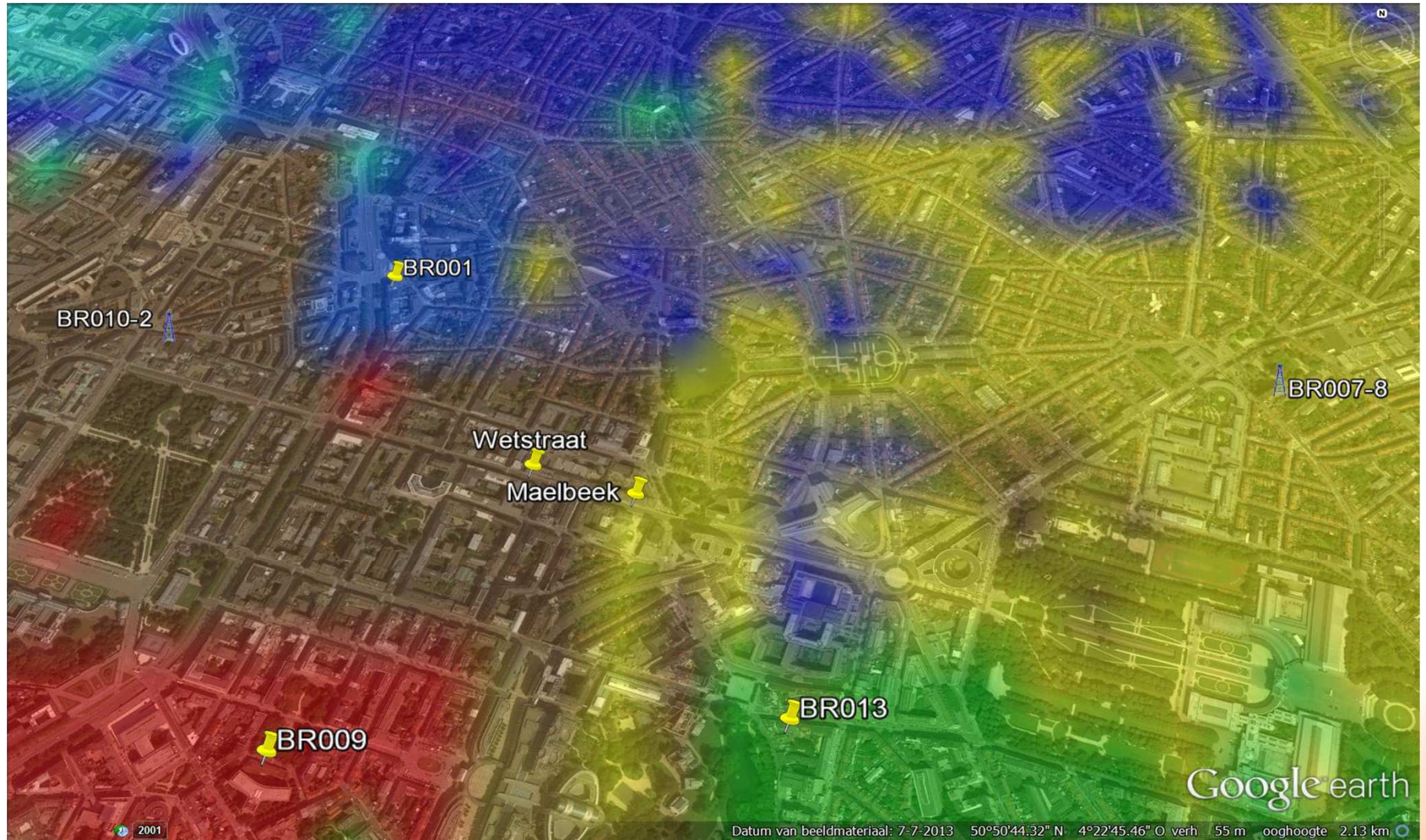

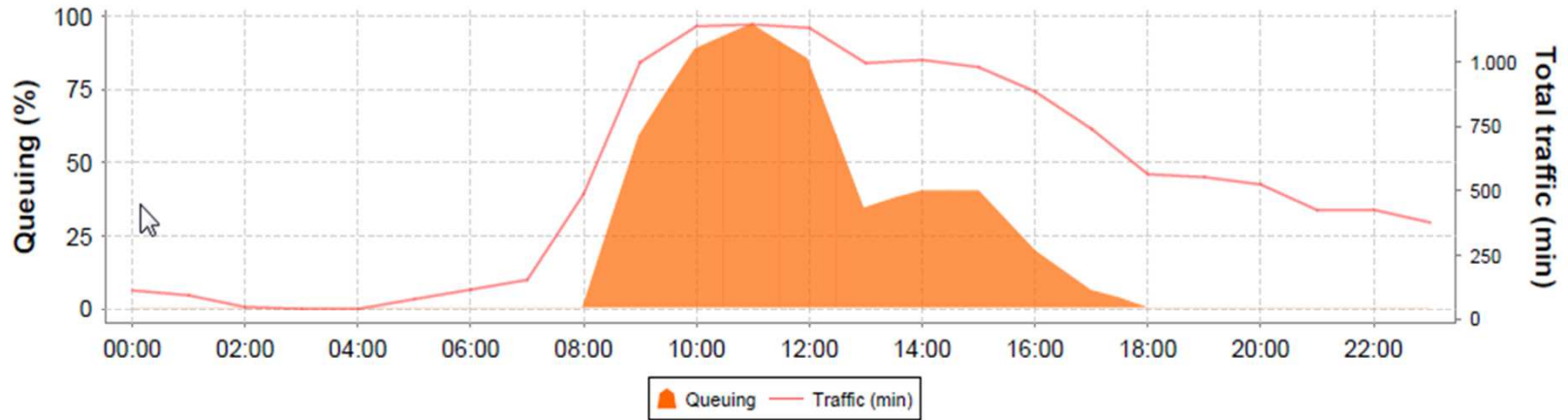
Couverage areas Antennas



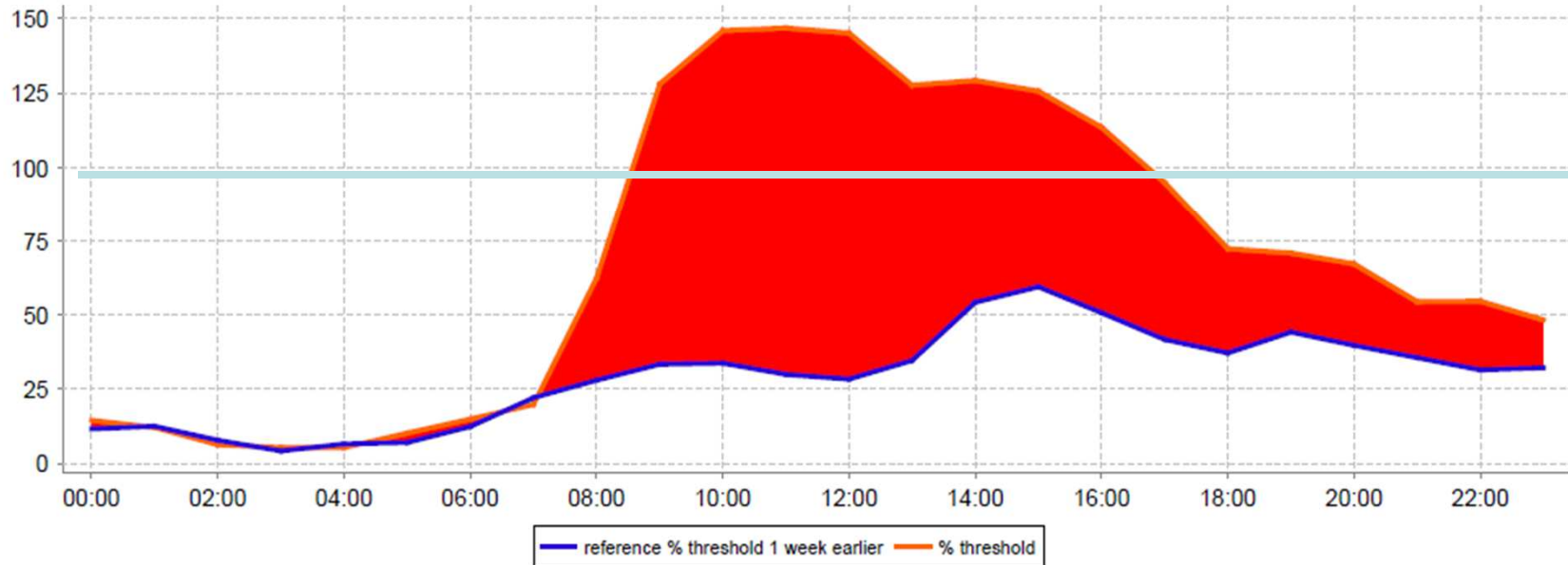

Traffic (min) per hour for BR010

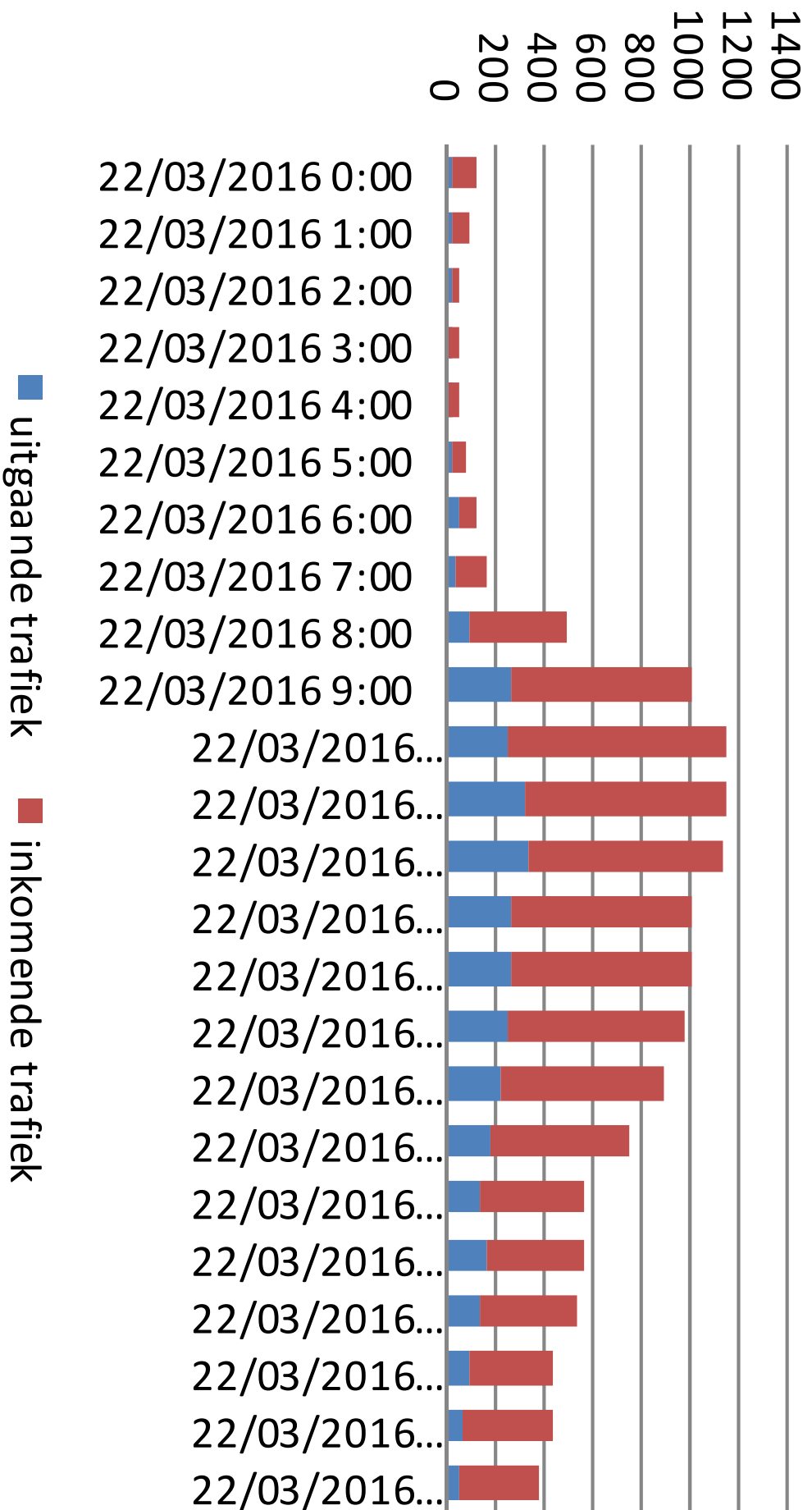


Traffic in % from threshold for BR010

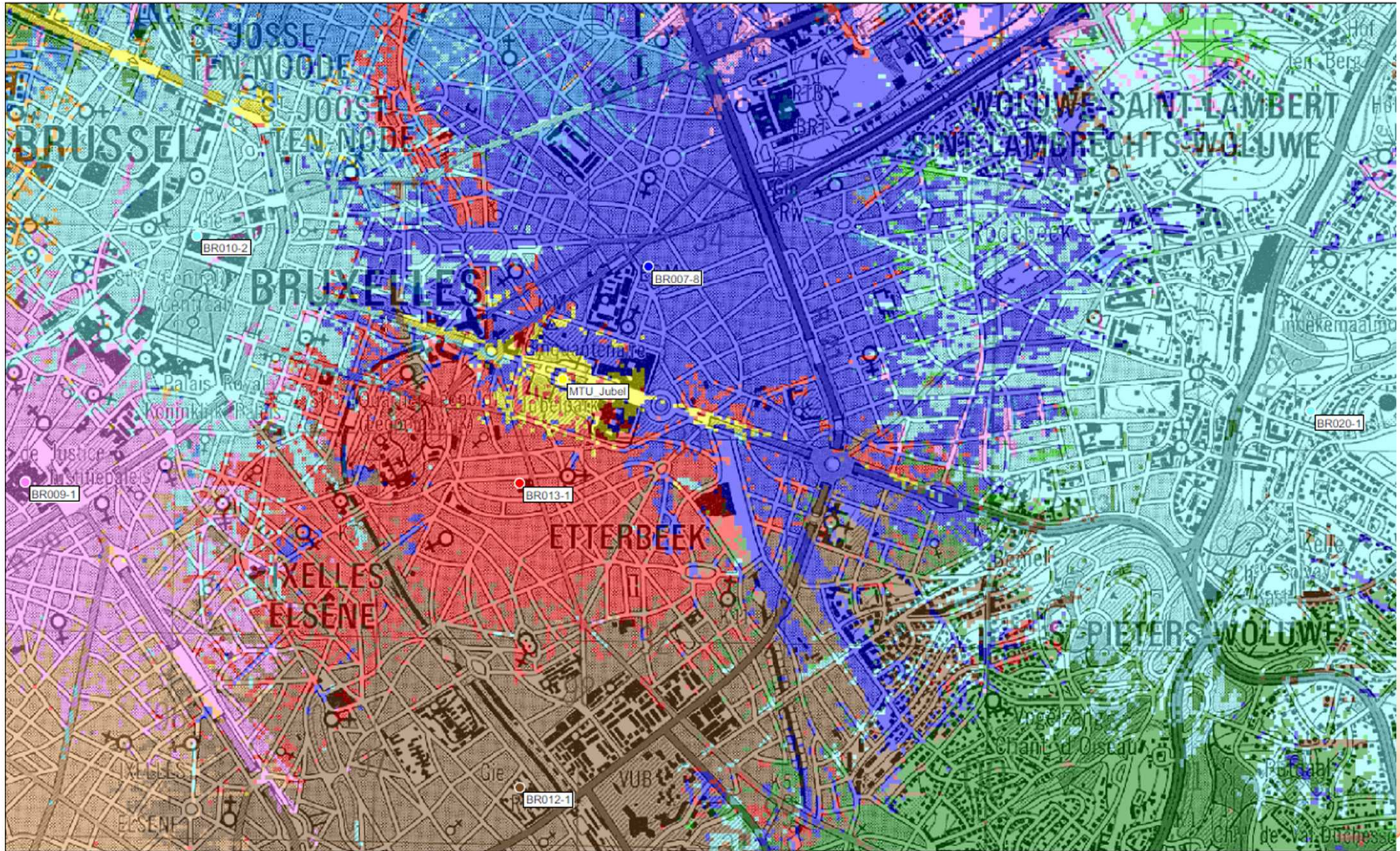

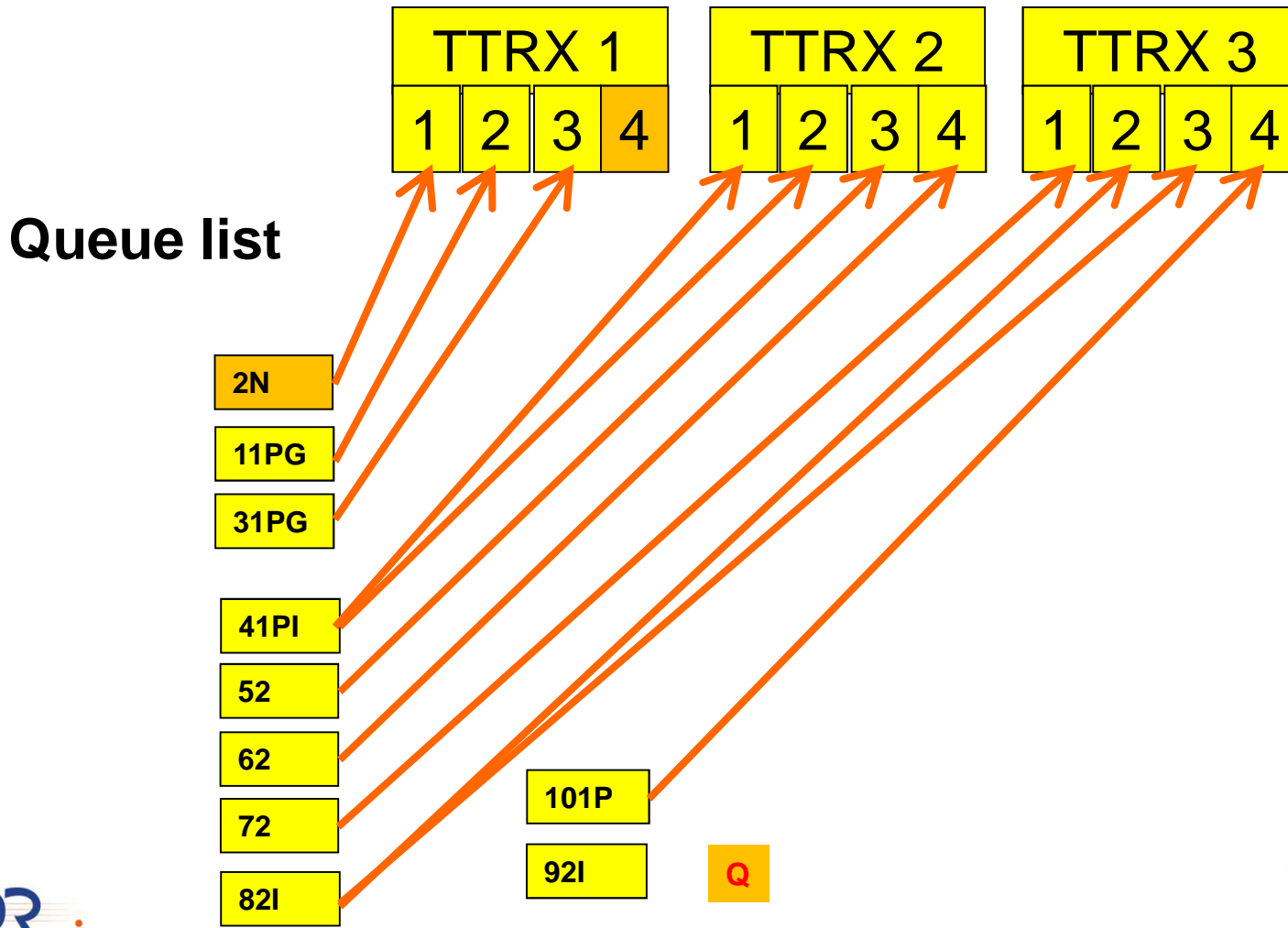

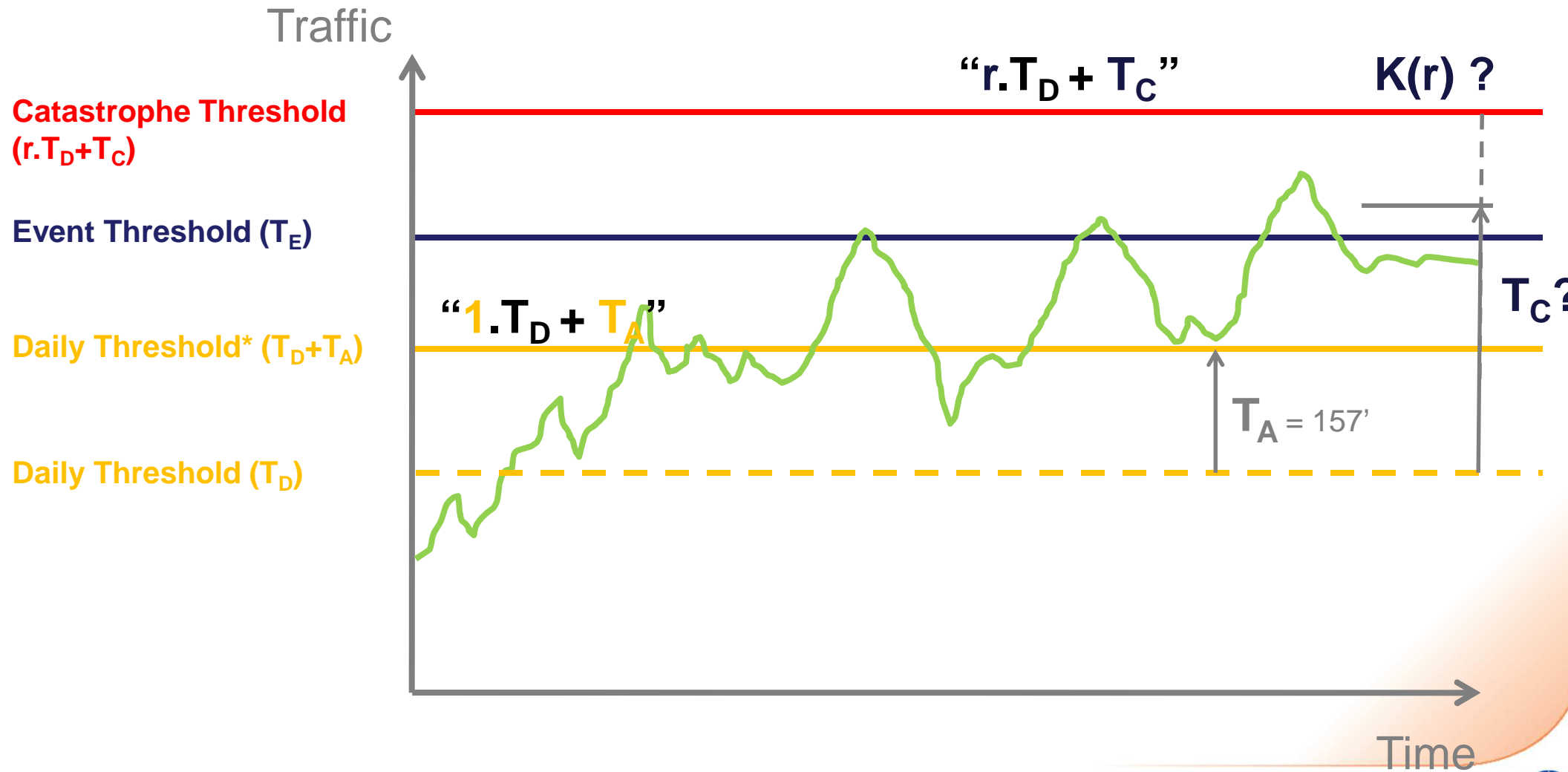

MCCH load

The MCCH (Multicast Control Channel) load shows the load on the control channel. Each call and SDS is first treated by the control channel for assigning the time slot. Too much load on the control channel can lead to the blocking of the respective Antenna. As a guideline is given that the traffic in uplink and downlink may not exceed 70%.
