- The results of Broadmap are very important
- Target date 2025 is much too late and nobody knows today what technology we will have in 2025
- Concerns about the process
 - Process seems to be intransparent
 - Selection criteria for PoCs in PCP is not clear
 - IPR issues
 - Role of 3GPP
 - In general PCP is a good idea but the way the PPI is not clear and shoul dbe explained and discussed in more detail.
 - Different TRL for solutions, some requirements may be realised immediately some later – several parallel developement and research streams needed?
