#### The example of BroadMap

- Initiated in a PSCE Conference (Paris-December 2014)
- PSCE acts as coordinator
- It is practitioner driven (15 practitioners from 15 countries, out of which 8 represent Ministries of Interior)
- It should bring the community of practitioners together (ie. workshop 10 Nov. in Brussels- 58 practitioners)
