Human Factors Working Group

- Secretary Jaenette Innes Reported on activities
 - UK Involvement in NPIA Multi-Agency Interoperability Programme
 - Cabinet Office work: Telecommunication sub-groups around the UK to explore human factors in multi-agency co-operation.
