

FP7 Collaborative research areas analysis of interest for PSCE

- Citizen Warning systems
- Fast and easy deployment in harsh environment
- Interoperability
- Rapid post incident systems to restore basic communications services
- First responder equipment
- NRBC threat management
- Use of pragmatic SDR and cognitive radio
- Video survey and capture
- Satellite complementarity
- Robust lightweight mobile search and rescue systems
- ICT: Net enabled systems, Situational awareness systems, Common Operating Picture, Coordinated response

- Create a common, up-to-date view of the contribution of various technology innovations to Public Safety
