Why plugging in to Joint Activities makes sense

FROM

TO

Developing based on research shared, discussed and disseminated at a conference. Developing based on the **real needs** through **observing** (procedures, tools, interoperability, knowledge, ...)

Explaining to researchers how reality functions.

Create a **realistic case experience**.

Ordering an expensive exercise for the sole purpose of testing, validating, demoing a single setting. Find a training center who is already organising an exercise, with a scenario relevant for your project: field exercise, table top, simulation – chemical accident, terrorism, ...
